<b>Working Group</b>	<b>Date</b>	<b>Activities</b>
<b>Identity Assurance WG</b>	Dec 2018	Revisions to the IAF Overview (IAF1000) continue. A draft was sent to current Kantara Approved CSPs and their input was received. The IAF Glossary (IAF1100) will be the next document to be revised.
<b>Identity Proofing and Verification Use Cases DG (NEW)</b>	Dec 2018	<p>The purpose of the Identity Proofing and Verification Use Cases DG is to gather use cases from organizations that perform or require identity assurance.</p> <p>The DG will create a Report containing the use cases, which will be processed into a format suitable for contribution into the ISO SC 27/WG 5 Study Period to collect and document Use Cases for an Identity Assurance Framework.</p> <p>The contribution is expected to go via the Kantara Initiative Liaison and may also be contributed to ISO via one or more National Standards Bodies as determined by the DG Participants. It is expected to run for only 3 months. <b>Assurance Program</b>	Dec 2018	<p>The program continues to attract a small but steady stream of service providers seeking 3<sup>rd</sup> party assessment, conformance and grant of Trust Mark for NIST 800-63-3.</p> <p>Revisions of the program documents relating to the application and renewal of Service Providers and Assessors continue, and are expected to be complete by March 2019.</p>

<p><b>Consent and Information Sharing WG</b></p>	<p>Dec 2018</p>	<p>The Group is well on the way to reframing Consent in general.</p> <p>The hard work and persistent effort of several team members resulted in a demo around sharing consent receipt information. Many people have experienced the demo at several conferences. Andrew Hughes and others have excited people many of whom have begun participating and contributing to the WG. Work continues to make improvements to the demo.</p> <p>Work on the demo has led to a series of high-level discussions around consent in general and how the WG would proceed with a feature set for a specification for the next release. These discussions have improved participants' understanding and grasping the language used around Consent Receipt which will undoubtedly result in improving the next version of the Consent Receipt Specification.</p> <p>A condensed version of the Consent Receipt specification is being prepared for submission to ISO SC27 as an annex to draft ISO 29184 Online Privacy Notices and Consent.</p>
<p><b>Consent Management Solutions WG</b></p>	<p>Dec 2018</p>	<p>The overall plan is to develop a document outline to capture Consent Management common practices, develop an interview protocol and survey, then gather data from as many organizations as possible. Then, the results will be analysed for common practices and areas where standardization could help. We have renewed commitments of participant time and a change of resource at the sponsor level, with contributed baseline material to build from.</p>
