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Describing good consent is often part of the privacy component of a trust framework. The following draft list is gleaned from PCTF, GDPR Recitals and Regulations, NSTIC relics, etc.

Characteristics -

- Core functionality oriented:
 - Fine-grain controls for release of attributes
 - Fine-grain controls for the release of values from a multi-valued attribute
 - Revocation
 - Purpose of use
 - Duration of consent
 - Transitivity of consent
 - Consent receipt generated
 - Mix of notice and consent capabilities
 - Integrated self-service management console
 - Integration of organizational/personal policies
 - Handling of negative rights in enterprise settings

- UX-oriented:
 - Positive action required to complete the process
 - Clear and explicit language
 - Handling sensitive attributes in a special manner
