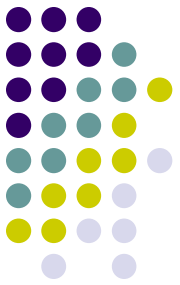

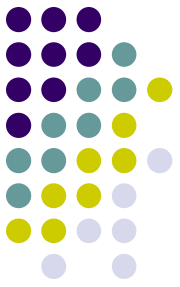

action

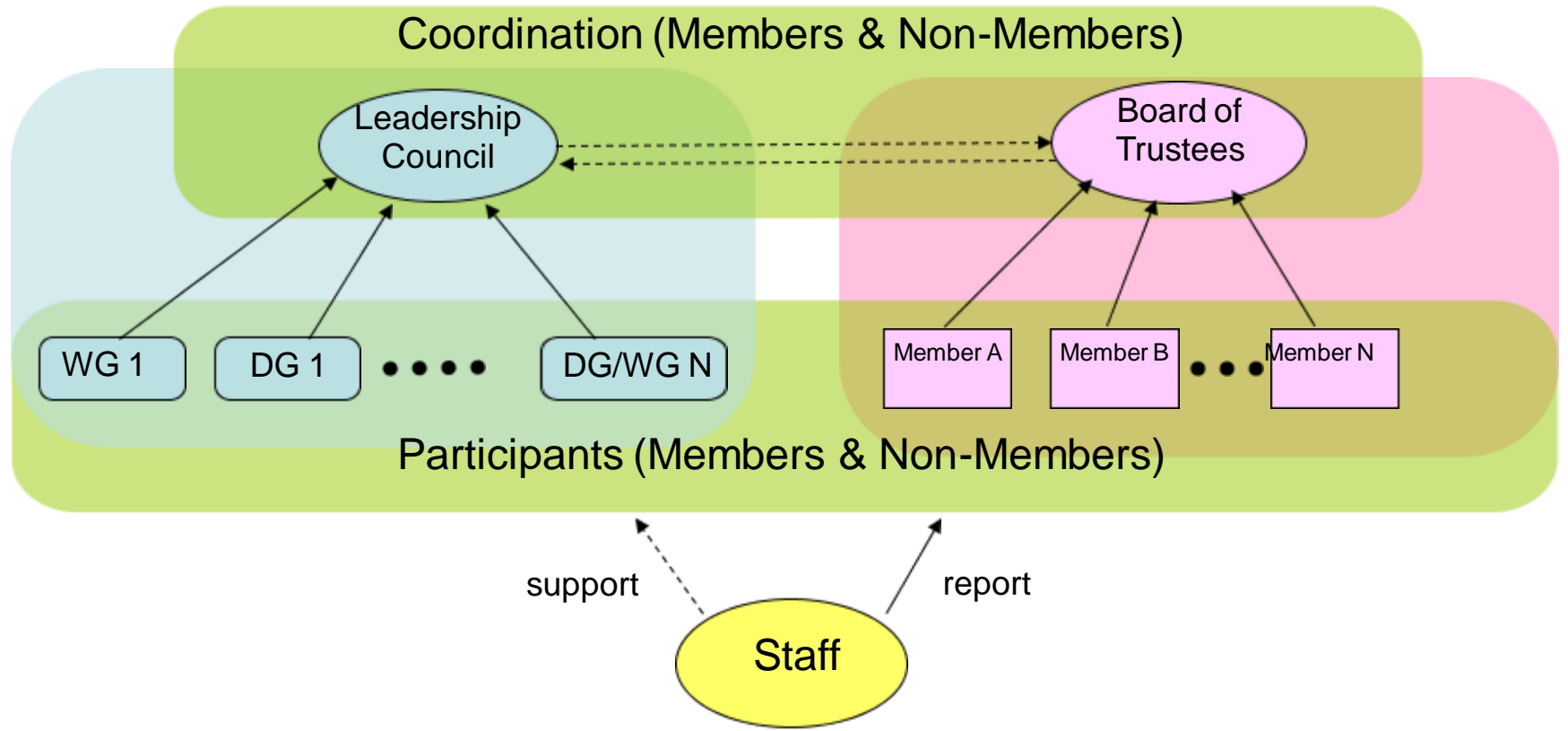
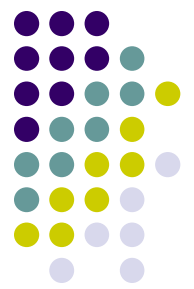
# Purpose
