Dear Mr. Hoerbe and Mr. Wallis,

I am working for the Dutch Standardisation Forum. We maintain a list with open standards for which a comply-or-explain regime is in place in the public sector. One of the standards on that list for some years now is SAML v2.0.

Currently we have the standard eHerkenning in procedure for inclusion in the list. This standard is basically a profile on SAML.

Last week the public consultation of the expert opinion started. Although the documentation mostly is only available in Dutch, I would like to ask you if you or one of your Kantara-colleagues could have a look at this SAML-profile and send us a reaction.

I herewith send you the specification document of the eHerkenning SAML profile that describes the interface between a public eService ("DV") and the so-called eRecognition broker ("HM"). There's also some general information available in English about the full concept of the framework eRecognition ("eHerkenning"): <http://www.eherkenning.nl/eRecognition>

The deadline for consultation reactions is the 23rd of September.
