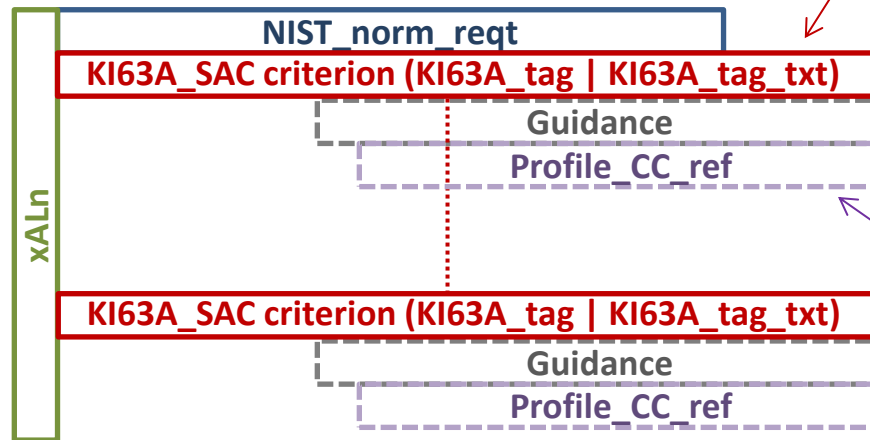


A NIST clause which is anything other than a 'NIST\_norm\_reqt' \*

**NIST\_non-norm\_reqt**

A NIST clause which imposes, explicitly or by inheritance, a 'SHALL' or a 'SHALL NOT' obligation

A unique KI tag associated exclusively with the KI criterion. Requires one or more criteria. (NB – there is differentiation between 800-63A, -63B and -63C)



xAL # at which the NIST requirement applies, hence at which the associated criterion/criteria apply. ‡

Guidance for implementors and assessors explicitly associated with the KI criterion. *FUTURE FEATURE*

Profile of the criterion applicable to country 'CC' and the designated reference. *FUTURE FEATURE unless implemented for 'Prof\_US\_FICAM'*

\* CAVEAT - by definition this provides for no KI criteria for any NIST clauses which employ 'SHOULD', 'MAY' or 'CAN' (inc. their inverses).

‡ xAL1 and xAL3 are a *FUTURE FEATURE* unless either or both apply to a criterion which is created to satisfy the immediate xAL2 need.
