This project will prepare text to contribute into that Study Period, and will also lead to the next version of Kantara receipt specification.</p> <p>Impact of this problem</p> <p>The next version of receipt specification will cover the same scope as the v1.1 with the addition of bugfixes and to address requests and comments on the v1.1 text.</p> <p>The next version of the receipt specification will accommodate additional use cases beyond the v1.1 concept of 'consent'. This will allow implementations that are not strictly 'consent-driven' while retaining connection to the v1.1 consent-driven implementations.</p>
